State Funded Prevention 0-3 Programs State-funded child development and family support services for expectant parents and families with children from birth to age 3 to help them build a strong foundation for learning and to prepare children for later school success. Services can be provided in center-based programs and/ or home visits.

Currently Southern 7 Head Start is working with Vienna Grade School to offer Birth to Three services in Vienna. More information is forthcoming.

Early Head Start

Early Head Start (EHS) programs serve infants and toddlers under the age of 3, and pregnant people. EHS programs provide intensive comprehensive child development and family support services to qualifying infants and toddlers and their families, and pregnant people and their families. Services are provided through home visiting.
